

What Is MiChild? How Do You Qualify?

MiChild is a health insurance program for uninsured children of Michigan's working families at a price the families can afford. MiChild services are provided by several HMO's and other health care plans throughout Michigan.

To qualify, children must be citizens of the U.S (some exceptions apply), live in Michigan, be under the age of 19, have no health insurance and meet the income requirements. The income requirements are based on an adjusted gross income that must be at or above 150% and below 200% of the federal poverty level. For children under one year of age, the adjusted gross income must be above 185% and at or below 200% of the federal poverty level.
